

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PAPER FILING YOUR FEDERAL TAX RETURN

NOTE: this only applies to married nonresident aliens. Unless you have been otherwise instructed by your reviewer, if you are not a married nonresident alien, DO NOT mail in your tax return. It will be e-filed.

 Print your Federal tax return. Generally, this begins on page 9 of the pdf file you received from GetYourRefund and ends right before your CT income tax return.
Form 1040 will begin with a page having the following heading.

- If your return includes a payment voucher, <u>do not mail this with your return</u>. The voucher is only to be used if you are mailing your payment separately from your return. Make all checks payable to "United States Treasury."
